



ERADICON PEST MANAGEMENT MICE TREATMENT PREPARATION GUIDE

Your home is scheduled to be treated for mice.

The treatment involves locating the entry points on both the interior and the exterior of the home and sealing them off with a rodent repelling construction foam to exclude the mice from entering the living area. Bait may be applied in the crawlspace or in secure bait stations in discreet locations. **YOU WILL NOT HAVE TO LEAVE.**

The treatment is **SAFE**, in harmony with EPA label instructions, and poses no risk to your family or pets.

PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

- **Please clear items from under the sink** to allow access to seal the openings around the pipes.
- **Please clear items from the stove and dishwasher** to allow us to inspect behind them for openings.
- **Please remove any items** from the top of the crawlspace hatch to allow access to the crawlspace.
- **Please clear items from hot water heater and furnace** to allow for inspection for openings.
- We will check the exterior for additional needed repairs such as replacing missing vent screens or sealing around utilities entering the structure to prevent future infestations.
- Our goal is to exclude the mice from your living space and allow the bait in the crawlspace to take effect over the course of the following weeks.
- **Please leave the bait stations until the mice are gone.** They are not traps and do not need to be thrown out as their purpose is not to catch the mice.
- **Be patient!** It will take several weeks to eliminate the entire population of mice.
