



ERADICON PEST MANAGEMENT FLEA TREATMENT PREPARATION GUIDE

Your home is scheduled to be treated for fleas.

The treatment involves applying a low odor liquid product that contains an IGR (insect growth regulator) which will kill fleas at adult, egg, and larval stages. It will be applied to the baseboards and the floors with a canister sprayer. **YOU WILL HAVE TO LEAVE FOR 4 - 5 HOURS.**

The treatment is **SAFE**, in harmony with EPA label instructions, and poses no risk to your family or pets.

PLEASE READ AND FOLLOW THESE GUIDELINES:

- **Floors must be cleared of clothing and other clutter** to allow treatment of the carpet surface.
- Rooms must be **cleaned and vacuumed.**
- **Remove any food that is exposed**, including pet food.
- **BE PREPARED TO LEAVE FOR 4 - 5 HOURS** to allow products to dry.
- **DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN OR PETS TO CONTACT TREATED SURFACES UNTIL SPRAY HAS DRIED.**
- **You may open windows or turn on fans** to help ventilate and product to dry quicker.
- **Please do not treat with store bought foggers or bombs.**
- After 24 hours, **vacuum frequently** to help with any remaining flea eggs or larvae.
