MICE TREATMENT

PREPARATION GUIDE

Your home is scheduled to be treated for mice.

The treatment involves identifying the entry points on both the interior and the exterior of the home and sealing them to prevent mice from entering your home. Bait stations and or traps may be set in discreet areas, and bait may be applied in the crawlspace. **YOU WILL NOT HAVE TO LEAVE.**

The treatment is **SAFE**, in harmony with EPA label instructions, and poses no risk to your family or pets.

PRE-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Please clear items from beneath the sink to allow access to inspect and seal openings.
- Please remove items from the stove and dishwasher so we can inspect behind them.
- Please clear items around the hot water heater and furnace so we can inspect behind them.
- Please locate the crawlspace hatch and remove any items on top of it to allow for access.

WHAT TO EXPECT

- Our goal is to exclude the mice from your living space and contain them to the crawlspace.
- We will apply bait in the crawlspace to eliminate the remaining mice living beneath the home.
- Any missing or damaged foundation vents will be repaired to prevent future mice intrusion.
- If bait stations are set inside the home, please leave them until the mice are gone.
- If any traps are set and catch a mouse, they can be thrown in the garbage.

Be patient! It may take several weeks to eliminate the population of mice.
